

The number of different styles and usage of the infographics is huge worldwide. Very different levels of detail, usage of 3D, photography, colours, abstraction.
































don't use pictures


... of sleep/ depressed people, or of unnatural nature





... in bad quality, with lack of contrast, blury etc






... with external commecial visual elements and/ or foreground perturbing objetcs (bottles, glasses, bags, etc.)





... cutting body parts or image caracteristics that make framing impossible





don't use massive text

... that will loose the nature of the meme if too long. Depending on the word but could be limited to 25-30 words
